Implant-Retained Dentures

Implant Retained Fixed Denture (All on Four) Attached to implants.

Denture fixed in place with screws to inter-connecting abutments.

Completing an ALL on Four case typically involves

- 1. an Interim Denture screwed in place on the day of surgery by the surgeon and assisted by a lab tech
- 2. then a definitive denture is fabricated after complete healing

At the time of surgery, code the implant placements, inter-connecting abutments and the interim denture. Typically, the surgeon codes for the implants and abutments and the restoring doctor codes for the interim denture and final denture.
